I wish to refer to your communication No. 274/09 dated 5 October 2009, by which your organization alleged that the Local and Regional Government Wage Bill restricts the right of trade unions to organize and bargain collectively in local and regional governments in Croatia.

Noting that, in the meantime, the Local and Regional Government Wage Bill was adopted by the Croatian Parliament on 19 February 2010 and came into force on 11 March 2010, the Committee of Experts on the Application of Conventions and Recommendations (CEACR) would be the regular supervisory mechanism which would be competent to assess the conformity of the legislation with the relevant international labour Conventions.

I would therefore be grateful if you would confirm your interest to draw the adopted legislation to the Committee's attention with respect to the Right to Organise and Collective Bargaining Convention, 1949 (No. 98), ratified by Croatia on 8 October 1991, along with a final version of the text should there have been any amendments, and any further matters your organization may wish to raise. Please send this communication to the Standards Department (NORMES), ILO Geneva.

Additionally, I am enclosing a copy of the handbook of procedures relating to international labour standards for your information.
